Friday is Deadline for NEUAC “Early Bird” Registrations

The deadline is fast approaching for “early bird” registration rates for the 2008 National Energy and Utility Affordability Conference: Mile High Solutions, presented by the National Low Income Energy Consortium and the National Fuel Funds Network. Registrations must be postmarked by Friday, May 2, to take advantage of the savings on conference fees.

After May 2, registrations will rise from \$300 to \$325 for attendees from nonprofits, while rates for participants from governments and tribes will go from \$450 to \$500. Corporate attendees will pay \$600 after May 2 compared with the discounted rate of \$525.

A record turnout is expected for the conference on June 16-18 at the Sheraton Denver (formerly the Adam’s Mark) Hotel.

The conference will also have a record number of workshops — more in three days than the NLIEC and NFFN previously offered in their two separate events spanning five consecutive days.

The 2008 conference also will feature a plenary forum Tuesday, June 17, examining energy policy and its impact on consumer prices. A policy forum Wednesday, June 18, looks at climate change legislation and its impact on low-income families.

Be sure to reserve your hotel rooms as soon as possible. Our original room block at a rate of \$159 per night plus tax for single or double occupancy already is sold out, however we have obtained a second block of rooms at the nightly rate of \$174 plus tax. When the second block of rooms is gone, lodging will only be available at overflow hotels — and at higher nightly rates.
